Hi All,

Shelly Russell has asked me to remind, especially the snowbirds, of our program to control weeds in our inner courtyards during the rainy season. I ***highly*** recommend that ESPECIALLY SNOWBIRDS sign up to having their weeds controlled by our landscaper, Jose Lovo.

I'm copying the email that I sent on April 10 about this program.

Hello fellow Woodlakers,

An issue that we have every summer is that many of us (myself included) leave for several months and those remaining have to look at the overgrown courtyards that we snowbirds have left behind. Condo life is, of course, different from stand-alone homes. Living close together, we have to look at our neighbors' courtyards each day. Our board strongly encourages all residents (not just snowbirds) to have our inner courtyards looked after during the summer.....when our plants and weeds grow amazingly fast!

Our landscaper, Jose Lovo, is offering the following program for inner courtyard maintenance.

- 1. Three weed sprays (May, July & September) for \$85.00 (or two weed sprays for \$57.00)***
- 2. One plant trimming for \$90.00***

If you would like one or both of these services done, please let Shelly Russell know.

You should then give or send Shelly a check made out to JOSE LOVO, and she will then arrange to have this done and give the checks to Jose. This is not just limited to snowbirds. Anyone at Woodlake can take advantage of this program. Again, this is for your INNER COURTYARD, and nowhere else.
